




Post-clipping alopecia

The linear line marks the biopsy site (line technique)





Haired telogen follicles



Pattern baldness




Canine Pattern Baldness

- ▶ Most common syndrome
 - Postauricular, ventral neck, thorax, and caudomedial thighs
 - Dachshund and other short-coated breeds
 - ▶ Whippet, min pinscher, greyhound, boston terrier
- ▶ Purely esthetic problem
- ▶ Histo: subtle; miniaturization of follicles
