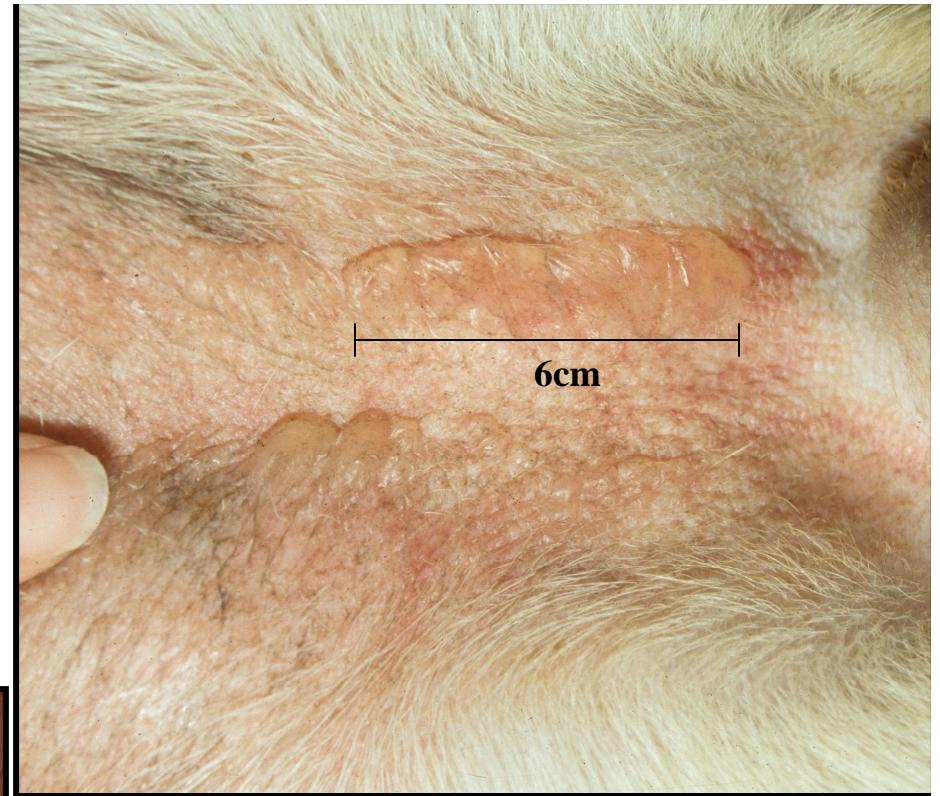
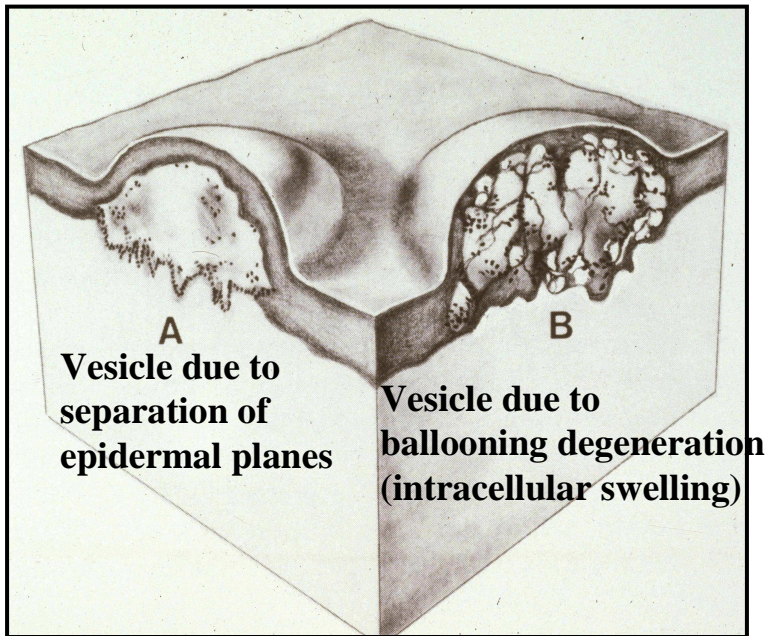
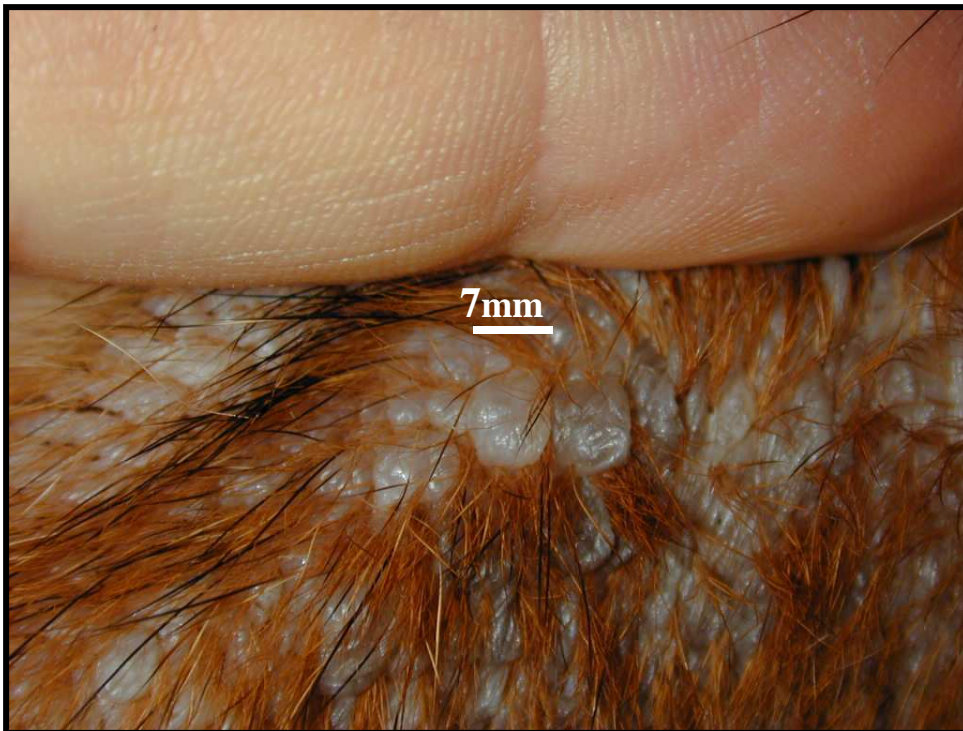


Vesicle and bulla (“blisters”)

- A vesicle is a sharply demarcated elevation of the epidermis, filled with clear fluid, up to 1cm in diameter. It may be intraepidermal or subepidermal
- A bulla is a vesicle greater than 1cm in diameter
