






Symmetric Lupoid Onychodystrophy (Onychitis)

- Aka “SLO”
- Interface rxn of claw folds only
- Characteristic clinical presentation
 - “10 nail dz”
 - Sloughing, brittle, soft nails


Lupoid onychodystrophy (Idiopathic Onychomadesis)

- Sudden onset onychomadesis
- Multiple nails
- Brittle, deformed, nails
- +/- pain, lameness
- GSD predisposed

Lichenoid dermatosis

- Seen in Labradors and few other breeds
- Hyperkeratotic plaques – often on face can be truncal or abdomen
- Histopath- lymphoplasmacytic lichenoid dermatitis with prominent parakeratotic hyperkeratosis
