The AAPSP is pleased to welcome Dr Francisco Uzal to Australia for the 2019 Annual Pathology Roadshow. Dr Uzal is Professor of Diagnostic Pathology and Chief of the San Bernardino branch of the California Animal Health and Food Safety Laboratory, UC Davis. He has been the coordinator of the Post-mortem Program for the California Horse Racing Board for the past 15 years and is a leading expert on clostridial diseases of animals. Dr Uzal has published more than 200 peer-reviewed articles, is the senior author of the “Alimentary Diseases” chapter for the 6th edition of *Jubb, Kennedy and Palmer’s Pathology of Domestic Animals*, and the first author of the recent textbook *Clostridial Diseases of Animals*. Dr Uzal is an Associate Editor and Photo Editor of the *Journal of Veterinary Diagnostic Investigation* and Associate Editor of *Anaerobe*, and an editorial board member of several other journals. He is President of the Davis-Thompson Foundation and of the Latin Comparative Pathology Group and has lectured in many countries throughout North and Latin America, Europe, Asia and Oceania.

Over two days, Dr Uzal will provide a thorough overview of equine gross and histopathology, including respiratory, cardiovascular, nervous, urinary, reproductive and musculoskeletal pathology, with a special focus on enteric pathology and clostridial diseases.
